- 3. Theme Law, Historical, Wisdom, Prophets
- 4. Length longest to shortest within their subject

#### New Testament

- 1. Genre Gospels, Historical Narrative, Letters, Apocalyptic
- 2. Author Paul, James, Peter, John
- **3.** Theme Jesus's life, early church, prison, pastoral, Revelation
- 4. Length longest to shortest within their subject

- \*United Israel
- 1050-930 BC
- \*Northern Kingdom: Israel
- 930-722 BC
- 722 BC Assyria invades

\*Southern Kingdom: Judah

- 930-586 BC
- **586 BC** Babylon invades; destroys Jerusalem temple; Israelites go into exile

\*Israel returns home

- 539 BC Persia defeats Babylon
- **520 BC** Israel begins to rebuild the temple
- 445 BC Nehemiah rebuilds walls of Jerusalem

- AD 57-59 in prison in Caesarea
- AD 59-65 in Rome; in prison from AD 60-62
- AD 65 Paul killed

# \*Other important dates:

- AD 62 James killed
- AD 64 great fire in Rome & persecution under Emperor Nero
- AD 65 Peter killed
- AD 70 Jerusalem temple destroyed
